
VOTE DANIEL HUTCHINS (Year 9) Our Local Candidate!

As part of developing Chosen Hill School's positive LGBTQ+ ethos and in response to requests from students within school, this week we have been excited to launch PRISM.

PRISM is a student lead club, which focuses primarily on helping LGBTQ+ students find their own voice and increase their confidence levels. Students who are allies are also welcome in the club.

PRISM is taking place on a Friday lunchtime from 1.30-2pm in the quiet room in the library. After half term it is open to all year groups.

The club will follow a weekly program of activities including quiet study, time to chat to other members of the group, movie time and relevant talks from outside speakers linking to LGBTQ+ issues. This week members have been set the challenge of developing a display area in the library linking to LGBTQ+ issues, the club and new positive LGBTQ+ related book reviews which the library have recently purchased.
