Students involved in Film in a Week will still need to choose a day trip.

If your child is on a residential, they do not need to select a day trip.

Coaches will leave promptly to ensure arrival times are met and students get the most out of the day. Please make sure your child can be in school on time for the trip departure.

If your child does not wish to go on a trip, they can take part in one of the following in-school activities, sign up via the School Gateway.

# Thursday Trip Choices

## **Longleat Safari Park - 50 spaces | 8:30am – 5:30pm | £25.10**

Discover the wild residents of Longleat, from lions and tigers to meerkats and koalas. Lose yourself in the UK's longest Hedge Maze, discover adventure playground, complete with zip wires, climbing frames, tube slides and of course, the medieval keep.

## **Ice Quest - 85 spaces | 9am – 3pm | £32.50**

Experience the thrill of ice skating at the indoor rink and step into the arena and prepare for the ultimate laser tag experience as you navigate through the immersive laser battlefield, strategising with teammates and outsmarting opponents. Lunch included.

## **West Midlands Safari Park - 50 spaces | 9am – 5:15pm | £36.50**

Home to a variety of all-weather attractions, including four miles of drive-through safari, a thrilling dinosaur exhibit and a theme park.

## **Brickhampton Court Golf Day - 12 spaces | 9am – 3pm | £45**

Spend the day with a golf pro on the driving range, putting green, and short game area, then take your skills onto the scenic Glevum course. Lunch included.

## **Chessington World of Adventure\* - 80 spaces | 8am – 6:30pm | £47.50**

With over 40 rides, attractions, plus over 1000 animals, Chessington is one of the most exciting UK Theme Parks!

*\*due to the distance and to get the most out of the day, the coach will be leaving school at **8am** - please only book this trip if you can ensure your child will be able to get to school by this time.*

## **Aztec Adventure- 48 spaces | 8:30am – 5:30pm | £48.00**

Slide, splash, climb, bounce, lounge, and jump across the Aqua Park, followed by team building activities including raft building, kata-kanuing and air rifles.

## **Bristol Activity Centre - 60 spaces | 8:30am – 4:30pm | £68.00**

A minimum of 5 games of Airsoft in “Call of Duty” and “Fortnight” inspired game maps including real tanks, helicopters, underground bunkers, and even a boat! Followed by an off road quad biking adventure.



# Trip Booking Information

The trips will be live and available to book on the School Gateway from 10am on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2026 until Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2026.

Places are limited and allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

Full payment required at the time of booking for trips costing £40 or less.

For trips over £40, a £25 deposit is required at booking, with the balance due no later than Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> April 2026.

At the point of deposit payment any trip changes will not be permitted.

The costs shown are based on meeting the minimum numbers for the trips to be viable. Places are available on a first come first served basis. Should we not reach the minimum numbers for a trip, the trip may be cancelled and in this instance a refund will be given.

Further information letters will be sent out nearer the time for each trip once student lists have been confirmed, including specific dress codes and timings. Your child will also be invited to a trip briefing meeting during the school day.

## **Pupil Premium**

# Enrichment Week FAQ

## **What happens during Enrichment week?**

There is a set timetable of fun and educational activities for the students. On Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> July, there is an opportunity for your child to take part in an off site trip as detailed in the pages in this booklet.

## **What time does my child need to be at school?**

Enrichment Week takes place during normal school hours, with the exception of the Thursday day trips. School will finish at 1:10pm on Friday.

## **What should my child wear?**

Enrichment Week is a non-uniform week for all students; students should wear suitable clothing for working both in classrooms and for sports and physical activity in line with the weather. Normal school rules apply to makeup and jewellery e.g. no false nails, eye lashes and additional piercings apart from a single stud in each ear lobe.

## **My child is already booked onto a residential trip during Enrichment Week, do I need to do anything?**

No. If your child is booked onto the Year 8 or 9 Camps, Croft Farm or Paris trip, there is no need for you to choose any further activities running that week.

## **When can I book the Thursday day trips?**

Day trips will be live on the School Gateway from 10am on 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2026. Full payment will be required (unless over £40) at the time of booking to secure your child's place. The deadline to make a trip selection is Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2026.

## **Why can I not see the trip my child would like to join?**

Some trips are very popular and have a capped number of places due to the number of tickets or size of coach we have been able to secure. Once trips are full you will no longer be able to see/book them on School Gateway.





# Enrichment Week FAQ

## **How much do the trips cost?**

Each trip has an individual cost. These can be found on page 9 of this booklet and on School Gateway when booking.

## **My child has changed their mind – can they swap to a different trip?**

Due to the administration involved, it is not possible to change activities once you have confirmed your choice by making payment.

## **My child does not want to go on any of the 'Out of school' trips offered?**

Any student who does not wish to go on an 'Out of school' trip on the Thursday should still attend school to complete in school activities.

## **My child is on the waiting list for a residential trip, should I still book a day trip?**

As we cannot guarantee those on the residential trip waiting lists a space, you should still book your child onto a day trip. Should a space on the residential trip then become available, this will be discussed on an individual basis.

## **When will I know that my child has a space on a trip?**

If you have paid in full and have a receipt of payment from the School Gateway, your child's space on the trip is secured.

## **My child is Pupil Premium, what support is available?**
