

Sixth Form Dress Code

The dress code for Sixth Form students embodies our conviction that the appearance of our students should reflect the professional environment in which they learn and their responsibility as role models. We are proud of the standard of uniform throughout Chosen Hill School and expect that this high standard will be maintained in the Sixth Form. We rely to a very great extent on the cooperation of parents in our efforts to give students a sense of pride in their appearance, and pride in the school. *If you are unsure, do the sensible thing – ask the Sixth Form team before you spend money or make a decision.*

Coat	-	Plain colour only, not denim or leather
Blazer (optional)	-	Black (smart office wear)
Trousers	-	Black (tailored – not jeans or leggings)
Skirt	-	Black (tailored) The skirt should not be shorter than 5cm above the top of the knee, or longer, when the student is standing.
Jumper/cardigan	-	School issue only. Please note hoodies are not permitted.
Shirt/Blouse	-	Plain white, with top button and collar (for tie)
Tie	-	Sixth Form tie (can be purchased from Student Finance Office)
Shoes/Boots	-	Sensible black or brown leather shoes or low-heeled boots
Tights	-	Black or neutral
1. Games Kit	-	Black and White sportswear and trainers. Please note: if students wish to use the 3G pitch they must have suitable footwear. Please see the pictures in our full Dress Code policy for guidance. Make up, jewellery and hairstyles should be discreet, should meet health and safety guidelines and must fit the high standards of dress at Chosen Hill School. Any type of face jewellery, except a discreet single nose stud is unacceptable.

2. Outdoor wear must not be worn in lessons or for any formal school event.

3. PE or Games kit cannot be worn other than for specified lessons or activities.

Students whose uniform standard consistently does not meet the school's expectations will face sanctions according to Sixth Form Code of Conduct and Achievement Policy.
